### **Elk Grove co. expands SoCal presence**

Concrete Washout Systems Inc. is expanding its presence in Southern California through licensing agreements with two companies that will distribute and service Concrete Washout Systems in the region.

The company has contracted with Pollution Solutions Inc. and Monarch Concrete Washout Inc. to distribute its Concrete Washout Bin.

The system is a watertight bin that catches concrete washout material and water, allowing contractors and workers to rinse out concrete trucks, pump and equipment on a construction site without illegal washing of materials into storm drains.

Monarch and Pollution Solutions will service builders and contractors in Ventura, Los Angeles and Orange counties.

Pollution Solutions began servicing Ventura and northern Los Angeles counties in the beginning of the year. It will add the San Joaquin County later in 2004, according to a Concrete Washout statement.

Monarch is a startup company formed specifically to distribute Concrete Washout Systems. It will begin servicing the Greater Los Angeles and Orange County area in April.

According to Kevin Mickelson, vice president of Concrete Washout Systems, the company has plans to expand aggressively and reach every major California market by the end of the summer.
